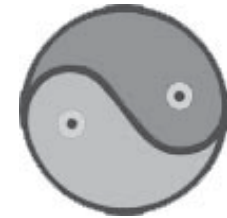
Ongoing counseling services, brief, career & grief services' fees are negotiable.
